Projects

Oral Cancer detection program

The Project is named "AASHWAS". The project focuses on the following aspects:

- Selection of Health volunteers and training
- Initial screening by volunteers
- Preliminary examination & data base preparation
- Treatment for Pre cancerous lesion & Biopsy of suspected case
- Guidance for established case
- Follow up in every six month.



Dental Hygiene

Preventive Dentistry can play a significant and decisive role in promoting good dental hygiene.

Preventive Dental Health Programme is a community based programme involving all the sections of people.

This project introduces and implements the principles and concepts of prevention of dental diseases right from infancy through childhood and adolescence.

The programme is to be promoted by the involvement of the community at every stage of implementation by mass education programmes.

Dentists and other health professionals involved in the project would impart knowledge on the preventive aspects of dental and oral hygiene at the grass root level.

Caries Free Generation

Caries Free Generation is a project promoted by the society to achieve the objectives of the society in ensuring the standards laid down by the World Health Organization in dental and oral health of the future generations. The project focuses on the following aspects:

- Prevention and interception of the progress of all dental and oral diseases
- Prevention and limitation of disabilities and
- / Provide rehabilitation





It covers the development and adoption of all measures taken to avert the initiation of dental disease and to effectively control their spread. The scope of the project covers the entire gamut of preventive, social and curative dental and oral health services.

Processes involved in the project

1. Selection of dental health workers

- Energetic, well communicating ladies with science back up or experience in health related works are preferred.
- One dental health worker for 1000 children.

2. Thorough training to dental health workers

- Conduct survey and prepare data base
- Conduct awareness programmes in systematic and scientific way
- Early detection of bad habits, dental & oral diseases, defective facial and dental development
- Provide guidance for early preventive programmes and treatment
- Conduct regular check up






Processes involved in the project

3. General Survey

- To identify target groups (0 to 10 yrs.)
- Grouping of target group 0-3, 3-6, 6-10 yrs
- Dental status and caries prevalence
- Completion of data base.

Operating Cost


- Transportation of staff, volunteers and patients

Infrastructure

- Mobile Clinic (Van)
- Medical Equipment
- LCDs, Loudspeakers etc.

Accessibility

- Camps in remote areas
- Lack of connectivity
- Lack of availability of volunteers
- Lack of access to medical supplies



Facts and Figures



Current group strength for camps : 500 children Expansion plans : 2000 children by 2016 and 5000 by 2017 in Kannur district



Age group of children treated : 5 to 7 vears



On an average, 12 visits per child per 5 years



Most commonly treated dental issues in the camps:

- Retention of milk tooth
- Dental Caries



Treatment costs: Rs. 1000/- per child per 5 years (for provision of basic treatments only)



Current Expenditure : Approximately Rs.125,000/- per year



Future requirements: Approximately Rs.170,000/- for expansion and scaling up



Current source of funding : Around 80% by Dental Care Society members and remaining by well wishers
